If your child is sent home with COVID symptoms or you choose to keep them at home due to COVID symptoms – a generic Year group work pack is available for collection from the school office.

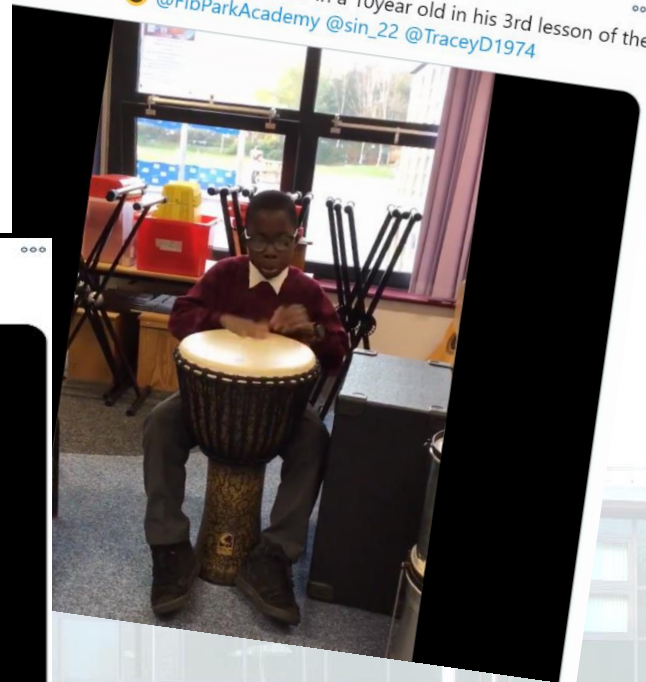
If we are advised by public health to isolate a bubble/year group, we ask that you have the Marvellous App, Zoom, My Maths and access the Oak National Academy.
