Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to all the parents who have completed the questionnaire about remote learning. The parent council will be meeting this coming week to discuss remote learning, so I am sure your feedback will be very useful. To support our remote learning, we will be trialing using break out rooms on zoom. This will enable the class teachers to split the class into smaller groups to support focus teaching and to encourage the children to share their ideas with their friends. All groups will be supported by an adult.

Zoom guidance:

- Teachers will only admit children known to them into the zoom session- children must sign in with their name.
- Teachers will be the last person to leave the meeting.
- Two adults will support the zoom sessions or additional zoom times.
- The children will be muted when the adults are teaching.
- Children will be encouraged to use the chat function- adults will monitor the chat. Any unacceptable chat will be stopped by the teacher
- Parents are encouraged to join in the zoom- for older children adults should be aware that the session is taking place.
- Zoom is our platform for face to face learning. All children should be appropriately dressed and ready for learning.

Please don't forget to share your work through Showbie or send it to your teacher using your year group email. Early years continue to use tapestry to share your learning. We love to see what you have been up to!

Making Maths Magical!

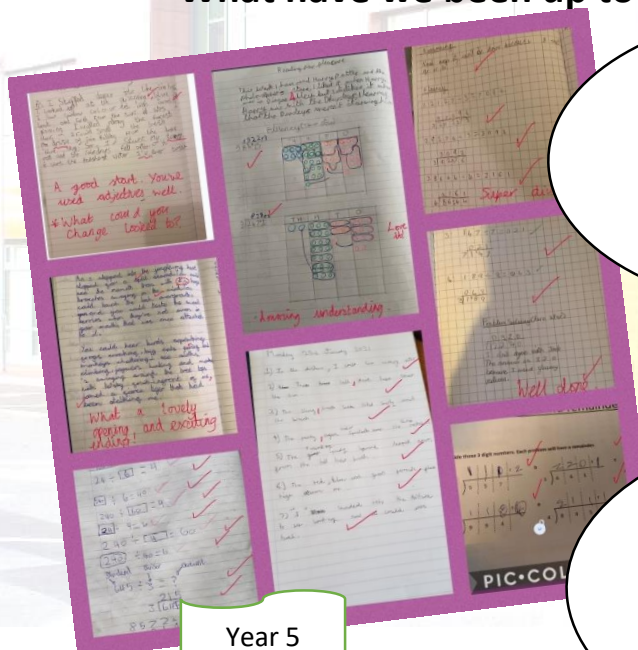
To celebrate Number Day this year—we're having a Virtual Maths Magician.

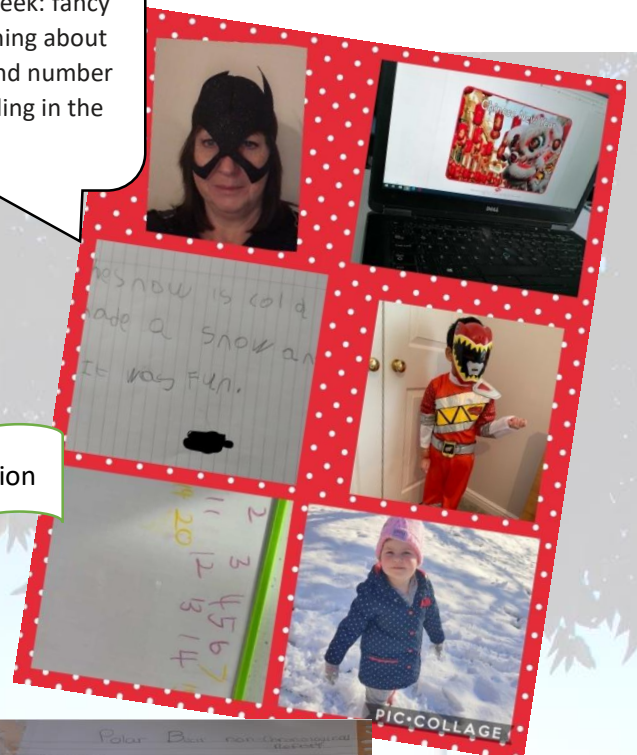

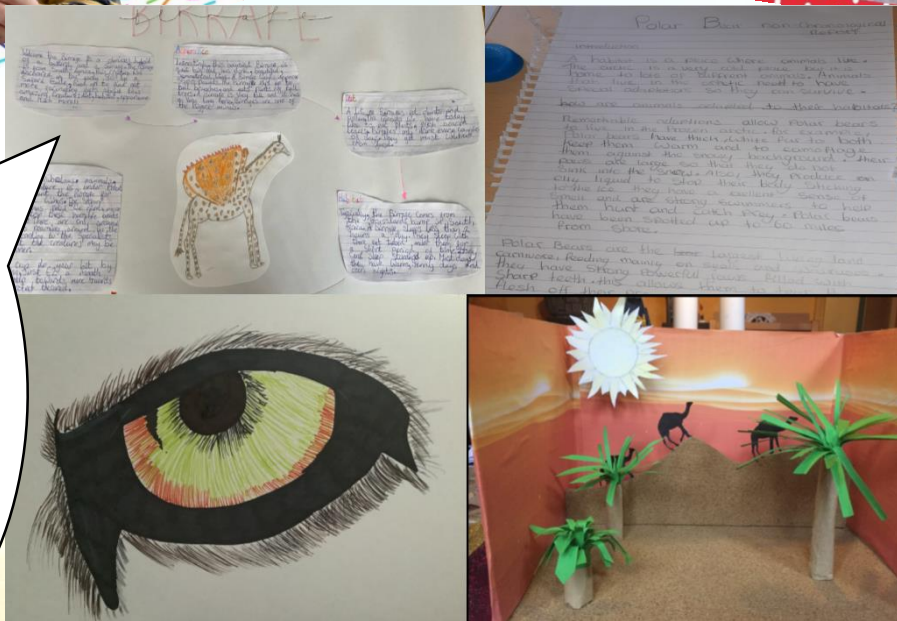
