Walsall have adopted a policy of applying a banding system of funding for SEND provision. This is now being introduced into EHCPs.

Alex Webley, SEND Team Manager is hoping to join the meetings (to be confirmed) and it is hoped that these sessions will clarify the implications for EHCPs and how children/young people with complex needs across many areas of need can be categorised into a single area.
