

Contingency Remote Learning Plan

From 1st September 2021, all children MUST attend school unless they have tested Positive for Covid or have Covid symptoms.

This plan will be applied in the following instances:

1. A child has **tested positive for Covid**
2. A child has **Covid symptoms** and is waiting for test results
3. A child has been **sent home with Covid symptoms**

This document outlines how Fibbersley Park Academy will ensure that your child continues to have access to their learning (as long as they are well enough to complete it). We acknowledge that some households have limited access to devices and would require to loan a device or obtain hard-copies of work and resources (such as pen, pencil and paper) which will be made available from our school office.

Software and online platforms

	<p>Class Charts will be used as a communication tool. Teachers and parents can have dialogue regarding completion of work – and some documents may be sent directly.</p>
	<p>https://classroom.thenational.academy/ The online lessons are free to all and offer a recorded taught session so that the children can access physical teaching from a teacher and then access work relating to that lesson within the same website. There are also hundreds of lessons specifically aimed at children with SEND needs and requiring additional support.</p>
	<p>https://www.mymaths.co.uk/ My Maths resources will be used to set Maths work linked directly to the taught curriculum; providing instant feedback.</p>
	<p>A Zoom session may be offered by request to ‘check-in’ with the child if deemed appropriate. It may also be used if a teacher thought that it may be supportive with the work set.</p>
	<p>TT Rockstars will all be utilised to support the acquisition and retention of basic core skills.</p>
	<p>Showbie, may be used by some teachers to provide work and feedback. It gives children the opportunity to collaborate.</p>
	<p>Purple Mash offers fun and engaging activities across the curriculum using a series of different templates.</p>

Work for children who are sent home from school with Covid Symptoms/waiting for test results

If a child is isolated from school i.e. **the child is sent home from school with Covid symptoms, they will be given a generic Year group work pack which will consist of:**

- Maths activity
- Writing activity
- Reading comprehension
- Science activity
- Spellings list
- PSHE Linked activity
- RE linked activity

<p>Class Charts/Text/Telephone call will be used by the teacher to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Check-in/see how the child is (2) Communicate messages regarding remote learning <p>If appropriate, a zoom session may be offered on request for Pupils who have tested positive and need to isolate for 10 days.</p> <p>The Class teacher will guide the parent/career to the most appropriate resources on Oak Academy to support Core Subjects for the duration of absence. Additional resources will be sent as an attachment via Class charts.</p> <p>If a child needs to loan a school device to complete work, Class teacher will notify Miss Reynolds & Mrs Jones – to organise.</p> <p>A generic workbook will be offered for collection/posted to family if unable to collect.</p> <p>Basic stationery items provided.</p>	<p>Parents to communicate test results to postbox@fibbersleyparkacademy.org.uk</p> <p>If child is entitled to benefit-related FSM food will be made available by Chartwells for collection (if required).</p> <p>If child is vulnerable in any way, the DSL/DSA will ensure that appropriate agencies are notified and arrange for regular safe and well checks via a phone call from the DSL/DSA (record on Safeguard).</p> <p>If a parent does not engage on Class charts, the Class teacher is to call the parents to discuss obstacles and support.</p> <p>For SEND pupils who are not working at year group expectations, work will be provided alongside their EHCP targets and the age/stage they are working at. An additional zoom session will be offered to support.</p> <p>Where children would normally receive additional support from SEND agencies, the SENDCO will make arrangements for those to continue via Teams/Zoom as long as the agencies engage.</p>
