How can we help those affected by a natural disaster?

Year 4 children will research natural disasters and their effects on different regions and people around the world. We will also learn about different charities which help victims of natural disasters.



Challenge Outcomes will be towards the end of Autumn tern. We will continue to follow government guidance; therefore, more details to follow.

Maths, Reading and English lessons continue to be taught daily.

In English, we are learning about non-chronological reports, adventure stories and poetry. In Maths, we are learning about place value, the four operations, length and conversion.

Science is taught weekly and our topic is:
