Do you have any new/unwanted gifts that you could donate for the Christmas Fayre? We would be very grateful for any suitable items that you could spare.

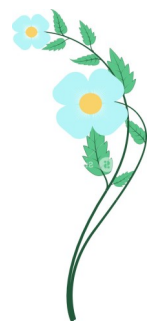

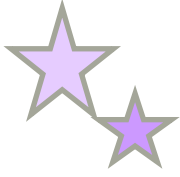
