*The Primary Mathematics Challenge (PMC) is a fun and exciting mathematical challenge for children in Years 5 & 6.*



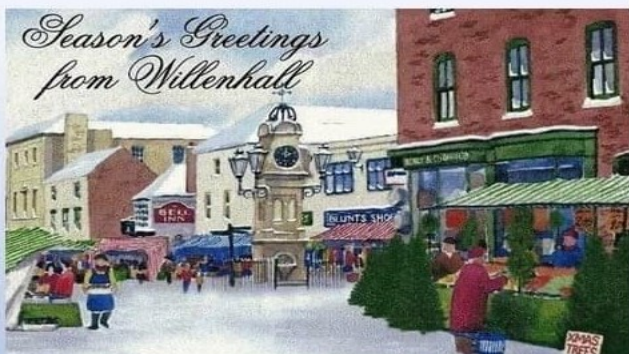
