English BC

This term we will be continuing our work on Phonics through the Rocket Phonics programme. We have introduced the children to the continuous style handwriting through our scheme Teach Handwriting. As of next week we will be sending weekly spellings home for the children to learn. We will complete a spelling test each Monday. In writing we will continue to focus on writing sentences that make sense, use of capial letters, full-stops correctly and introduce the use of question marks. The children will be encouraged to check their own wrok for improvements.

Maths



This term we will be focusing on,

- Measuring length and weight.
- Position and direction.
- Adding and subtracting 1-digit and 2-digit numbers.
- 2d and 3d Shapes
- Ordering numbers to 100.
- Recognising half past times.
