We thank you in advance for your support. If you have any further questions, please speak to your child's class teacher.



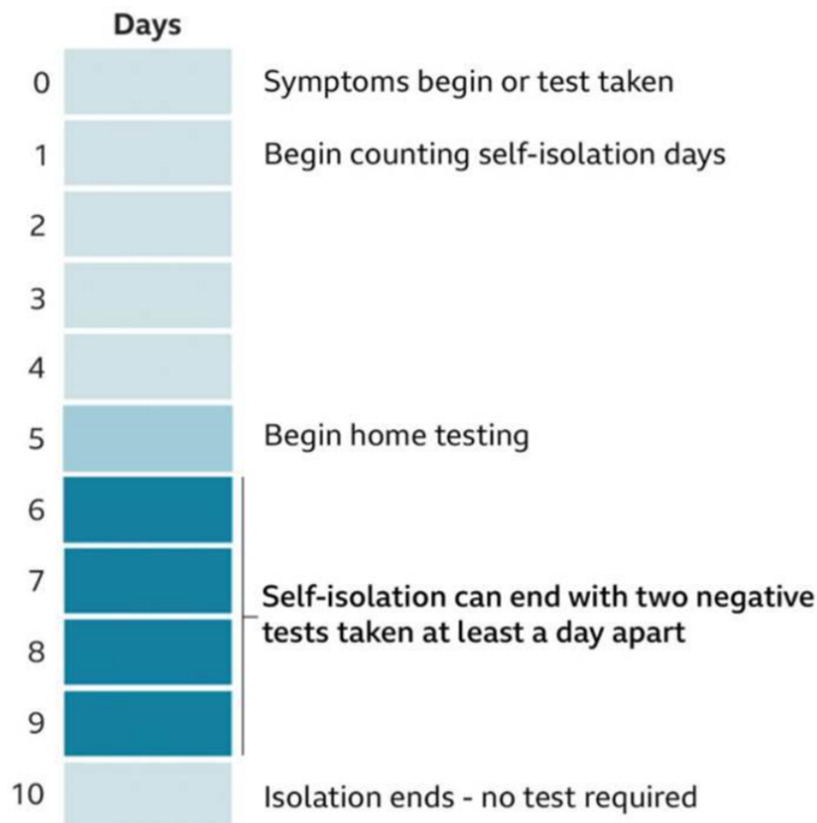
Absences
