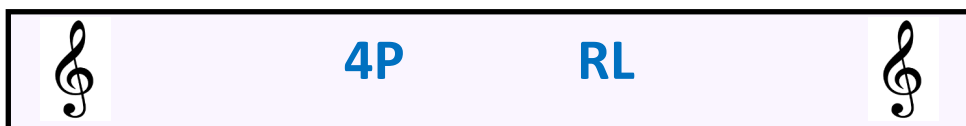

With a whole host of activities for you to enjoy, it's going to be GREAT!!!

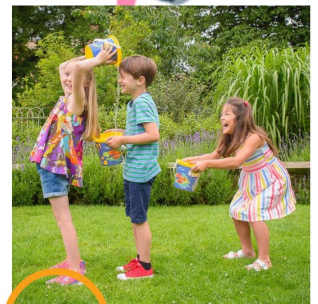
The subsidised cost of the day is £2 per child or £4 for a family of 3 or more brothers and sisters.
