Curriculum Newsletter

WELCOME BACK!

All of the year 5 team are so pleased with how well the children have come back from the break, ready to start the summer term with us.

Maths

This term we are focussing on further applying the strategies we have learnt so far this year. We will be revising and applying the 4 operations in various contexts, estimating calculations, further exploring shape and measure and reviewing our statistics knowledge. All Maths lesson follow the structure: Arithmetic, Reasoning, Fluency and Application. There will be more emphasis on application this term.

<u>Reading</u>

Within our reading sessions, the children will be exposed to a wide range of text genres and have opportunities to read for pleasure weekly. Our class text focus for this term is 'Anglo- Saxon Boy'. All sessions in reading focus around the reading VIPERS, with questions linked to: vocabulary, inference, predict, explain, retrieve or summarise/ sequence.

English

The children will be focussing on our class text this term. They will have the opportunity to write for entertainment, to inform and to explain. All of the children have been exposed to the Year 5 writing skills. Within this term, the children will be reviewing and applying these skills throughout all of their writing.

Science

Our Science Topic this term is Animals including humans. This will include, understanding life cycles and categorising living things. We will also be taking part in various scientific enquiries.

During this unit the children will be reviewing their knowledge of the Anglo-Saxons. It will heavily focus on History, Art and Computing but will provide Geography opportunities.
