Free iPad For Children With Visual Impairment

Guide Dogs Tech for All services, offers **FREE** iPads to visually impaired children (aged 3-18). iPads have excellent accessibility features built-in as standard, such as screen magnification, voiceover and audio descriptions, to make many activities easier, like reading in larger fonts, magnifying photos and keeping in touch with friends.

They also offer grants for other types of assistive technology if an iPad is not right for your child.

Walsall Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF)


