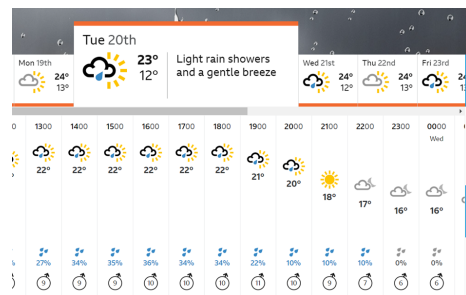

On **Tuesday 18th July** Years 4-6 will take part in FPA's Annual **Colour Run**. The Colour Run is a sponsored fundraiser for The Teenage Cancer Trust charity.

Every day, seven young people aged 13-24 hear the words "you have cancer". They will each need specialised nursing care and support to get them through it. Teenage Cancer Trust is the only UK charity dedicated to meeting this vital need – so no young person faces cancer alone.

We have placed a collection bucket in Main Reception and will be selling merchandise as well. All monies raised will go solely to the Teenage Cancer Trust. Our Colour Run is for children-only and further details will follow for Years 4, 5 and 6. Thank you in advance for any donations you may be able to make.

PE Kit Reminders:

All children should have a PE kit in school on their PE days, if you are unsure when these are please check with your child's class teacher. The PE kit expectations are as follows:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain black shorts
- Black PE pumps or plain black/white trainers

Grey tracksuit (for winter)

We ask that on PE days all jewellery is removed at home before coming into school. If this is not possible, and the child cannot remove the items independently then piercings will be covered with tape for safety, and any bracelets that are worn for religious reasons will be covered with a sweatband.

Children will be given spare kit where possible if they have not got access to their own, to ensure full participation in the PE curriculum.
