Industrial Action Reminder: All classes affected by the NEU industrial action have been notified.

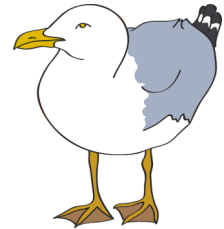
Year 2 trip:
