
As you will be aware school will open at 12:20pm on Monday October 2nd for Mrs Gould's funeral. Thank you for your kind words and understanding at this difficult time

PE Kit Reminders:

All children should have a PE kit in school on their PE days, if you are unsure when these are please check with your child's class teacher. The PE kit expectations are as follows:

• Plain white t-shirt /Plain black shorts / Black PE pumps or plain black/white trainers / Grey tracksuit (for winter)

We ask that on PE days all jewellery is removed at home before coming into school. If this is not possible, and the child cannot remove the items independently then piercings will be covered with tape for safety, and any bracelets that are worn for religious reasons will be covered with a sweatband.

Children will be given spare kit where possible if they have not got access to their own, to ensure full participation in the PE curriculum.
