- Grey tracksuit (for winter)

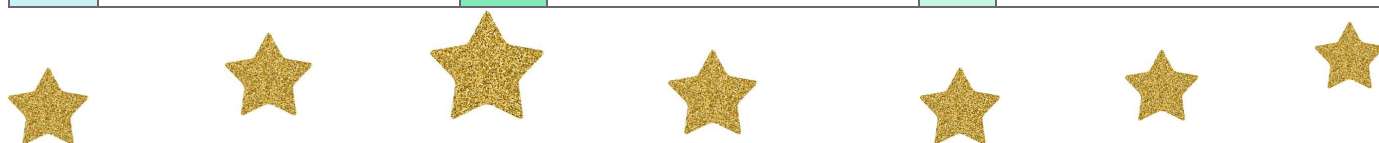
