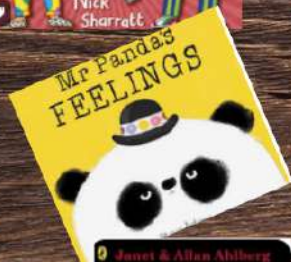
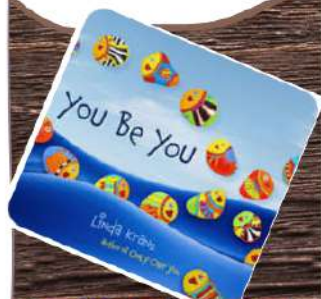
Our theme this half term is: 'Getting to know you'

Phonics

We have started teaching phonics.

The sounds we are learning this half term are:
s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, l,

Reading is an integral part of your child's learning and reading stories to your child helps them increase their vocabulary, imagination and helps them make sense of the world around them.

We will be sending a book bag home in the next few weeks with a school reading book and a reading record. (could you please write in the record book when you listen to your child read)

School Values

This half term we will be focusing on 'Unity'

Maths

We are learning to:

- subitise (recognising small groups of objects from 1 to 5 without counting them).
- Count with 1:1 correspondence.
- make numbers in different ways (composition)
- to compare the amounts of different objects.
- to make repeating patterns
